

## SECURITY AT SHOWS

In light of recent events the Kennel Club would like to issue a reminder to all Societies of the importance of security at dog shows. The Kennel Club understands that due to the nature of dog shows and the quantity of paraphernalia exhibitors bring it would be extremely difficult for show organisers to take on the issue of security alone, therefore we would reiterate the advice being given by the Police and security services, that everyone in the UK should remain vigilant and this applies to those organising and taking part in dog shows.

The importance of exhibitors feeling that they and their dogs are safe when attending a show cannot be underestimated. We would therefore remind you of the importance of the need for show organisers and exhibitors to remain mindful of potential dangers and that all visitors generally need to be vigilant and alert.

**Should you see anything suspicious or of concern**, please alert the Show Manager, Mr David Hunt and/or any Club Officer immediately. If it is a package or bag you are concerned about, please do **NOT** attempt to move it or examine it yourself.

**Should it be necessary for the hall to be evacuated**, please remember that evacuation should be carried out as speedily but as safely as possible, as in the case of a fire. It is important that you do not block the exit routes with cages or bags and follow any instructions given to you by the Show Manager/Club Management regarding evacuation procedures.

Please do not obstruct gangways with **cages, pens, grooming tables, trolleys and dogs**. Storage Space will be made available for trolleys/cages.

The Kennel Club requests that all dogs in soft cages are **NOT** left unattended at any time, for safety reasons.

The Committee will do its utmost to ensure the safety of the dogs brought for exhibition but it must be clearly understood by exhibitors and all other persons at the Show that the Committee will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dogs or property, or personal injury whether arising from accident or any other cause whatsoever.

## **Judge's CV –**

### **Margaret Bailey (Grindelvald)**

I have been very lucky, my working life has been with dogs. When I left school I worked as an Animal Technician in a dog breeding unit, at a medical and veterinary research company. Eventually I took over the breeding programme, gaining valuable experience in dog breeding. I also attended college, studying animal husbandry.

After ten years breeding dogs, I decided to set up my own dog grooming business. I trained at the Nottingham School of dog grooming; I retired four years ago after 39 years running a successful business.

Ever keen to learn more about dogs, I attended college on a two year part-time course, City and Guilds Canine Studies, covering psychology, physiology, the history and dog training. I passed with a distinction. The college offered me the position to take over the course, I had to pass City and Guilds adult teacher trainers exams, then I started lecturing canine studies, alongside running my own business and giving grooming lectures at college.

I've had dogs all my life, we started showing Whippets 35 years ago and we have always had working Terriers. We decided to have a Border Terrier, purchasing her in 1989 and started showing her in 1990. She was the daughter of Ch. Brannigan of Brumberhill, lovely foundation bitch. She produced Grindelvald it's a Breeze and she produced Ch. Grindelvald Sandpiper 9CC's. We brought Sandpipers daughter in and she went on to produce Ch. Grindelvald in Full Cry, another multi CC winner. Also he was top Border Terrier stud dog in 2014/15 and again in 2017/18.

I have been a committee member for the Midland Border Terrier Club for 25 years. I feel it is essential to put something back into the clubs by helping and giving support.

I started judging in 1996 and awarding CC's from 2007. Also been judging in Sweden and Denmark.

It's an honour to be judging my sixth Championship Show at the Southern Border Terrier Club.

### **SPECIAL NOTES**

1. Exhibitors are reminded that puppies under 4 months of age are not allowed within the precincts of the show.
2. Please clean up any mess promptly as required by the Kennel Club and ensure children and dogs are kept under control at all times.
3. In accordance with Kennel Club guidelines, Exhibitors must display exhibit number/owner identification on their crate, cage or container at all times.

at their discretion and dogs aged four calendar months and over are eligible to enter Not for Competition at all Kennel Club licensed shows. Furthermore, dogs aged four calendar months and over are eligible to enter Match competitions.

19. **Modifications:** No modifications will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
20. **Dog Fouling:** Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is requested to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s) at any Kennel Club Licensed Show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches. Adequate receptacles for the disposal of such fouling will be provided.
21. **Entries:** All postal entries must be made on or before **15th May 2020** (Postmark) upon the entry form enclosed for that purpose together with the correct entry fee to the Show Secretary by the above date or the entry will not be accepted. If required evidence of despatch must be given. Entries may also be made online at [www.dog.biz](http://www.dog.biz) (Online entries close: **12 noon on 25th May 2020**). All dogs must be registered or transferred at the Kennel Club before the Show. Every exhibitor making an entry or entries for this Show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Kennel Club Limited Rules and Show Regulations and it is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.
22. All exhibits must be accompanied. The Committee cannot accept or dispatch unaccompanied dogs.
23. **Exclusion of Dogs:** The Committee are empowered to exclude or remove any dog which is not in a fit state for exhibition either from disease, vice, natural or other causes and if such exclusion takes place, either before or after the dog is judged, the entry fee will be forfeited.
24. **Judges:** Should the judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement the Executive Committee reserve the right of appointing another judge to fulfil his/her duties. The judges will be instructed and empowered to withhold the prize(s) in any class if in his/her opinion the dog(s) exhibited do not possess sufficient merit. The judge is not empowered to give prizes beyond those offered in this Schedule of prizes, and such awards shall not have any value or count as a win except with the consent of the Secretary, first obtained in writing.
25. All Rules and Regulations or Definitions and Instructions of the nature of rules and regulations printed for convenience in other parts of this Schedule, shall be deemed to be the Regulations of the Committee and shall have the same effect as if they formed part of these Regulations.

27. **Regulations F - F9 Exhibition of Dogs:**
  - a) No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time whilst at the licensed venue including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches.
  - b) The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches.

and are requested to prevent their dogs from fouling on  
or near this entrance.**

**Parents are reminded that they will be responsible for  
any damage caused by their children within the

### **COLLECTING RING**

**A collecting ring will be in use at this show and exhibitors are required to present themselves with exhibit in this ring, in good time, prior to completion of judging of the previous class.**

EXHIBITORS ARE ALLOWED TO REMOVE THEIR EXHIBITS FROM THE SHOW AFTER THEY HAVE COMPETED IN THEIR CLASS(ES)

### **IMPORTANCE OF CHECKING ELIGIBILITY BEFORE ENTERING A SHOW**

Following a series of recent disqualifications from awards, which are disappointing for everyone concerned, the Kennel Club would like to remind exhibitors of the importance of checking their dog's eligibility for classes before submitting an entry for a show.

The Kennel Club would particularly like to draw the attention of exhibitors to the importance of understanding that overseas awards which count towards an overseas Champion title (CAC, CACIB, Green Star etc) are the equivalent of a CC in the UK. Likewise, Reserve CACs etc are the equivalent of a Reserve CC. These awards should be taken into account when looking at eligibility and entering shows in the UK.

If in doubt, please contact the Kennel Club for advice or enter the dog in the open class which, by definition, is open to all.

## Definitions of Classes

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of **Postal** entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. **Friday 8th May 2020**. Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in breed classes but when entering for Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A First Prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

- (1) **Withdrawal**  
The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations F.(1).19.
- (2) **Transfer**
  - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
  - b) If an exhibit is entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or twenty four calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class respectively for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
  - c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
  - d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

**MINOR PUPPY:** For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**PUPPY:** For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**JUNIOR:** For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**YEARLING:** For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**NOVICE:** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

**POST GRADUATE:** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**MID LIMIT:** For dogs which have not become Show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won five or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Mid Limit, Limit or Open Classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

**LIMIT:** For dogs which have not become show Champions under the Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**OPEN:** For all dogs of the breed for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

**VETERAN:** For dogs of not less than seven years and over on the first day of the Show.

**SPECIAL OPEN WORKING:** For dogs holding Working Certificates issued by the Southern Border Terrier Club **only**. Please give number on entry form.

**NOT FOR COMPETITION:** Societies may at their discretion, accept Not For Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society. Dogs of 4 months of age may be entered NFC. Please give full details on entry form.

## Rules and Regulations

1. **Opening of Show:** The Show will open at 9.30 am.
2. **Arrival of Dogs:** Dogs will be received until 12 noon, after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management.
3. **Judging Time:** Judging will commence at 10.00 am and exhibitors will be responsible for their dogs being on time for judging.
4. **Removal of Dogs:** Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. **Entry Fees:** **Members:** First entry £12.00 per dog; **Non Members:** First entry £14.00 per dog; All subsequent entries with the same dog and dogs entered NFC £2.00. Entries can be made online at [www.dog.biz](http://www.dog.biz).
6. **Prize Money:** BIS £25.00; BOS £10.00; BPIS £10.00; 1st £5.00; 2nd £4.00; 3rd £3.00; Res £2.00; VHC £1.00.
7. **Refusal of Entries:** The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
8. **Puppies:** Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
9. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
10. **Best Puppy in Show.** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best in Show is a puppy it should automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Show. Where the Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should also automatically be Best Puppy in Show. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best in Show.
11. **Best in Show.** Best in Show must be selected from the exhibits declared Best of Sex. If a Reserve Best in Show is to be selected, the eligible dogs are those declared Best Opposite Sex and Reserve Best of Sex to the exhibit declared Best in Show.
12. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
13. Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
14. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) - Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
15. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
16. **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
  - When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
  - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
  - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
  - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
  - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
  - Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
  - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.
17. **WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**
17. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
18. **Not for Competition:** Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.  
**Regulation F.1.c:** Only dogs of six calendar months of age and over on the day of the show are eligible for exhibition at Kennel Club licensed shows. However societies may accept Not for Competition entries

## REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F (B)

- 1 These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.
  - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
  - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A 42.
- 2
  - (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the Show.
  - (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- 3 No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
  - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
  - (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed.
  - (c) Operations to prevent breeding, provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
- 4 The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 5 An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class, an objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate) to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 6 Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

### DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS

**Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.**

**If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.**

### WELFARE OF DOGS

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Limited Rules and Regulations.

Right to Refuse Entries: Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.
