

## DIRECTIONS TO THE VENUE

### FROM M1 (Southbound) (Approximately 6 minutes)

Leave at Junction 30 on A616 (Newark/Chesterfield).

At next roundabout take A619 (Chesterfield).

In approximately 3 miles, enter Staveley, over pedestrian crossing, over Railway Bridge to Roundabout. Turn left at the Roundabout.

After 200 yards, turn left at the traffic lights by the Sports centre, signposted Inkersall, Poolsbrook and Speedwell Rooms.

Venue on the right after 200 yards. Car Park is just past the building.

### FROM M1 (Northbound)

Leave at Junction 29A exit signposted A6192/Bolsover/A632.

At 1st Roundabout take 3rd exit onto Erin Road.

At 2nd Roundabout continue on Erin Road signed STAVELEY (A6129) - keep on this road.

After Poolsbrook Country Park (on the left) take 2nd exit on left to Cemetery Road.

At end of Cemetery Road turn right and venue is 200 yards on the left.

## NOTICES

- ❖ All Exhibits must be in numerical order in their respective classes.
- ❖ Use of Videos and Mobile Phones - please see rules 22 and 23.
- ❖ Flash Photography is not permitted during judging.
- ❖ Please obtain the owner's permission before photographing their dog.
- ❖ DO NOT leave valuables unattended.
- ❖ **Please use the exercise area in the car park and clean up after your dog.**
- ❖ Only dogs entered for exhibition or entered 'Not for Competition' will be allowed within the precincts of the show. Spectator Dogs must be registered at a cost of £3.00.
- ❖ No chalking allowed.
- ❖ No overnight parking directly outside the venue.
- ❖ **Clean up after your dog and dispose waste into suitable receptacle. DO NOT leave waste/bags for others to clear up.**
- ❖ Children to be supervised at all times by an adult (over 18 yrs of age) who will be responsible for their conduct at the show.

### EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

In accordance with Kennel Club guidelines, Exhibitors must display exhibit number/owner identification on their crate, cage or container at all times.

20. The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of all dogs entered for competition and for any property entrusted to it, but it must be clearly understood by exhibitors and any other persons that the Committee will not be responsible for the entire or partial loss, or detention of, or damage to any dog or person for any cause whatsoever, nor for any act of omission of themselves, their officers, servants, agents and others, and it is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.
21. Entry fees will not be refunded once an entry has been made.
22. The use of Video Cameras during the Judging is not allowed.
23. Mobile Phones must be switched off or set to 'Silent' mode when in the vicinity of the Judging Ring.
24. Passes will not be sent out. Please enclose a stamped addressed envelope when sending your entries if confirmation is required.

## DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of postal entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. **Monday 2nd September 2019**. Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value. If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

- (1) Withdrawal  
The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulation 20.
- (2) Transfer
  - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
  - b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class to the Open Class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
  - c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open Class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
  - d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

**MINOR PUPPY** For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**PUPPY** For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**JUNIOR** For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**YEARLING** For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty-four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**GRADUATE** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or 4 or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**POST GRADUATE** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or 5 or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**MID LIMIT** For dogs which have not become show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won 5 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**LIMIT** For dogs which have not become show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**OPEN** For all dogs of the breed for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

**VETERAN** For dogs of not less than 7 years of age on the first day of the Show.

**NOT FOR COMPETITION** Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Show will open at 8.30 a.m.
2. Dogs will be received until 12 noon after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management.
3. Judging will commence at 9.00 am.
4. Exhibits may be removed from the show after their Judging has been completed. The show will close half an hour after all Judging has been completed.
5. **ENTRY FEES:** Members: £13.00 first entry per dog; £2.00 each subsequent entry with the same dog  
Non-Members: £15.00 first entry per dog; £2.00 each subsequent entry with the same dog. Not for Competition £3.00 per dog, Spectator Dog £3.00. Catalogues: £4.00 pre-paid with entries. Membership: Single or Joint £10.00; Overseas £12.00.
6. Prize Money: 1st - £5.00; 2nd - £3.00; 3rd - 2.00; Reserve - £1.00.
7. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
8. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
9. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
10. **Best Puppy in Show.** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and received a first prize in a class at the same Show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best in Show is a puppy it should automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Show. Where the Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should also automatically be Best Puppy in Show. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best in Show.
11. **Best in Show.** Best in Show must be selected from the exhibits declared Best of Sex. If a Reserve Best in Show is to be selected, the eligible dogs are those declared Best Opposite Sex and Reserve Best of Sex to the exhibit declared Best in Show.
12. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
13. Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
14. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) - Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
15. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
16. **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS.** Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
  - When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
  - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
  - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
  - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
  - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
  - Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
  - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.
17. **WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**  
Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
18. **Not for Competition:** Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
19. No modifications will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.

## INFORMATION FROM THE JUDGES

### Fiona Mycroft (Supeta)

I would like to thank South Yorkshire Whippet Club for inviting me to judge dogs at the 2019 Championship Show, I feel very honoured to have been asked to judge here for my first set of CCs – I just wish Nev & Edith Newton were here to watch me.

I have been involved in Whippets my entire life and share the Supeta affix with my mother Sue Mycroft. Our passion for the breed came from my father Pete who had racing Whippets as a child – we owe everything to him really. When I came along he decided he would like another Whippet so my mother acquired our first Whippet 'Mulcair On A Promise' who was bred by Jackie Whitaker-Crosby (Mulcair) and produced us some lovely puppies and a RCC winner. We also acquired another bitch 'Chiming Bells at Courthill' from Roger Stock (Courthill) bred by Nick Gourley & Andy Leonard (Witchstone), who produced us our own 'Supeta's Caughtcha 'Wishin'. These lines went on to produce us 8 homebred Champions both in the UK and overseas, our first being Peppa 'Ch Supeta's Bootilicious Babe ShCM' who was by Ch & Aus Ch Nevedith Kfa Kraka and out of Supeta's Loverlee (a daughter of Caughtcha 'Wishin) who went on to take 7 CCs, a Group 2 and a RCC from veteran at Crufts 2014. We have also been fortunate to make up a German Champion with our first import bitch whose pedigree goes back to our own breeding and is now producing well for our kennel.

I have been showing our Whippets since the tender age of 6 and have been blessed to have a lot of success in the show ring with them. I have been actively judging Whippets since the age of 16 and have been fortunate enough to have been mentored by some of the Top kennels in Whippets but most importantly my mother who has taught me so much about this amazing breed. I am very much looking forward to my first CC appointment and the opportunity to go over your lovely dogs.

### Rachel Snelgrove (Huntinghill)

I would like to thank the Committee of the South Yorkshire Whippet Club for inviting me to Judge Bitches at this year's Championship Show, it is an honour to be asked and I was delighted to accept their invitation. Sadly I shall miss the presence of two highly respected members of this club in Nev and Edith Newton who over the years have not only been two good friends but also mentors during my years in our lovely breed.

I owned my first Whippet Toffee at the age of 9, Silver Lady of Huntinghill, who was born in 1983 and under the guidance of Daphne Raines, Tumblers, she became my first registered show dog.

Prior to this I had been showing various breeds in the working group for my mother and other exhibitors plus also enjoying success in Junior Handling competitions. After Toffee came into our lives our love for the Breed ensured that many others have followed over the years with some successes from a variety of good breeding lines and in a variety of colours.

Of course winning BPIB, RBCC and BCC at Crufts in consecutive years with Chelsea, Ch. Huntinghill Jazzalicious JW, has to be one memory I hold dear including winning WOTY with her twice hosted by SYWC. Also doing the double at three Breed clubs shows with her and her litter brother Joe, Ch. Huntinghill The Jazz Man JW, is another lovely memory amongst many others. I cannot fail to mention here another 'heart dog', Mr Wiz, who through the kindness of June Minns, Juneric, became my naughty white companion in 1996. I took my first BCC at Bath 1987 aged 13 handling a bitch owned and bred by the Battershalls, Shallmoor Whippets, under Breed Judge Shelagh Thompson of Walkabout Whippets.

But I have also been extremely lucky to have been mentored over the years by some very kind and knowledgeable people within our breed, some of whom are very sadly no longer with us or not showing today. These people happily shared their great knowledge and love of the breed and I will always respect them for helping me along the way and for allowing me to learn from them and also for their valued friendship.

## REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F (B)

- 1 These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.
  - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
  - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A 42.
- 2
  - (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the Show.
  - (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- 3 No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
  - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
  - (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed.
  - (c) Operations to prevent breeding, provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
- 4 The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 5 An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class, an objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate) to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 6 Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

### DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS

**Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.**

**If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.**
