INSTRUCTIONS. This form must be used by one person only (or partnership), Writing MUST BE IN INK OR INDELIBLE PENCIL. Use one line only for each dog. The name of the dog and all details as recorded with the Kennel Club must be given on this entry form. If an error is made the dog may be disqualified by the Committee of the Kennel Club. All dogs must be REGISTERED at the Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor. If the registration or transfer of ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute proof of postage of such applications may be required by The Kennel Club. Puppies under six months of age on the first day of the show cannot be entered for competition. On no account will entries be accepted without fees. If a dog is in the process of Registration or Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after its name. Please put classes in numerical order and USE BLOCK CAPITALS throughout when completing this entry form. The Kennel Club Authority to Compete number (for dogs registered and resident outside the UK) must be stated or the entry will be returned, PLEASE CHECK ALL DETAILS BEFORE POSTING.

I/we agree without reservation that any Veterinary Surgeon operating on any of my/our dogs in such a way that the operation alters the natural conformation of the dog or part thereof may report such operations to the Kennel Club. I/we declare that where any alteration has been made to the natural conformation of the dog(s) the relevant permission to show has been granted by the Kennel Club. I/we further declare that, I/we believe to the best of my/our knowledge that the dogs are not liable to disqualification under Kennel Club Show Regulations. I/we also confirm that I/we understand the eligibility of the classes entered.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

It is most important to put your correct postal address on the entry forms.

Failure to do so may result in your passes being delayed or not received by you at all. Address should include:

House number (not just house name) - Postal Town - Correct Postcode.

IMPORTANT NOTE **EXHIBITORS PASS SYSTEM**

For On-line entries only

You will receive your Exhibitors Passes at the appropriate time through your personal on-line account - **Not through the post**

Approximately 2 weeks before the show you will be informed by email that your Exhibitors Passes are in your account + by SMS text to your mobile phone if you wish.

Take these steps: Login to your account and choose the option 'My Account History' there you will see with your Show Entry record a line saying Download your Exhibitors Pass - click this link and your Exhibitors Pass will appear - print it - take it to the show.

There may also be a Show Information Leaflet - print this.

Be aware that the Exhibitors Passes are not sent to you by email but will be in your www.dog.biz account ready to be printed off by you and used at the show in the normal way. This will be a great saving to the Society of the postal costs; envelopes etc.

Exhibitors making postal entries will receive their Exhibitors Passes by Post in the usual way.

DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.

If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

ADDRESS WITHHELD FOR PUBLICATION.

Please note the points below:

- Tick the box near your name and address on the front of the entry form if you do NOT want your ADDRESS to appear in the catalogue. Your name will still be printed above your dog records as normal.
- 2. Your address is still needed for the sending out of schedules and exhibitors passes. So you must still enter your address in the normal way.
- 3. If you have ticked the box your address will **NOT** be printed in any catalogues compiled by Higham Press. If in the future you would like your address to be printed then you must **WRITE** directly to Higham Press, New Street, Higham, Alfreton, Derbyshire DE55 6BP, or email mail@highampress.co.uk.Telephone requests will **NOT** be accepted.

SPECTATOR DOGS

Spectator Dogs must go to the Secretary's Office on arrival. Security will be checking all dogs out.

WELFARE OF DOGS

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Limited Rules and Regulations.

Right to Refuse Entries: Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.
