In so doing those appointed as officers and committee members accept that they are jointly and severally responsible for the organisation of the show and that this is a binding undertaking (vide Kennel Club General Show Regulations F4 and F5).

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1 The Show will open at 7.30 a.m.
- 2 Dogs will be received until 11.30 a.m. and after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by any special permission of the Show Management. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that their exhibits are available for judging when required.
- The proposed order of judging will be announced, following the closing of entries, on the Society and Higham Press websites and will be sent out with passes to those exhibitors making postal entries. All judging will commence at 9.00am unless otherwise advised in the information sent out with passes and/ or published on the Society's web site.
- 4 a. Exhibits may be removed from the show after their judging has been completed.
 - b. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club.
 - The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed at which time all dogs must be removed.
- Entry Fees: All fees include VAT (VAT Reg GB 212 0398 07). All 1st entry fees include benching fee. Breeds with CCs - On or before Tuesday 2nd August £30.00, from Wednesday 3rd August £32.00. Breeds without CCs, AVNSC, AV Import Register, Stakes Classes - On or before Tuesday 2nd August £15.00, from Wednesday 3rd August £17.00. Not for Competition - On or before Tuesday 2nd August £13.50, from Wednesday 3rd August £15.50. Subsequent entries with the same dog - £5.00. Spectator Dog Fee (payable on the day) - £10.00. Group catalogues (pre-paid only) £6.00. Day catalogues (prepaid only) £8.00. Unclaimed catalogues may be offered for re-sale at the show but only from 11.00 a.m. onwards on the relevant day. Car Parking pre-paid with entries - £3.50. Car Parking on the day - £10.00. All paid up members of the Society will be sent a Members' Car Park Pass and a copy of the show schedule by post prior to the date of the show. Exhibitors arriving at the show without either a Members' or a prepaid Exhibitors' Car Park Pass will be directed to the Public Car Park. Members of the public will be admitted to the show and allowed to use the designated Public Car Parking area on payment of £10.00 per vehicle. Pre-paid caravans/motor homes £55.00 (pre-paid with entry fees) or, subject to availability of space, £65.00 on arrival at the show. No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct fees. ENTRY FEES ONCE RECEIVED CAN ONLY BE REFUNDED ON PRODUCTION OF VETERINARY AND/OR MEDICAL CERTIFICATES RECEIVED PRIOR TO THE SHOW AND SUPPORTING SUCH CLAIMS. In the event of cancellation or abandonment of the show claims for refunds will be passed to the Society's insurers. Cheques, to be drawn on a UK bank only, should be made payable to "Richmond Dog Show Society".

- 6 There will be no prize money in Breed Classes at this show.
- 7 The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 8 Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition, i.e. exhibits must be born prior to 9th March 2022.
- 9 The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.

10 Best Puppy in Show (if scheduled)

Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it may, at the discretion of the judge, be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it may, at the discretion of the judge, be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.

 A. <u>Shows judged on the Group System</u> - (Definition; Shows judged on Group System - Refer to Regulation F(1)27.b)

1) Best Puppy in Breed

A Best Puppy may be declared in each breed from puppies entered in the breed classes.

A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Not Separately classified class(es).

A Best Puppy may be declared from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register class(es).

2) Best Puppy in Group

Best puppy in group and subsequent puppy group placings must be selected from:-

a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed.

- b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group.
- c) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group.
- 3) Best Puppy in Show

Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in group winners.

1 Best in Show

The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best of Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register.

A. Shows Judged on the Group System

Best of Breed

Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.

NOTE: The Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register award relevant to a Category 3 Breed will not be confirmed until the dog has passed an examination by the General and Group Championship Show Veterinary Surgeon.

2) Best of Group

Best of Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:-

- (a) The Best of Breed winners in each group.
- (b) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each Group.
- (c) The dog declared Best from Any Variety Imported Breed Register class or classes in each Group.

NOTE: The dog declared Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/ Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register from a breed designated by The Kennel Club as a Category 3 Breed is not eligible to compete in the Group competition unless it has passed an examination by the Show's Veterinary Surgeon. If the dog fails to pass the examination it is ineligible to compete in the relevant Group.

3) Best in Show

Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.

- 12 Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
- 13 Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
- 14 All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- 15 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- 16 DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS. Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
 - When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - · Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - · When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty
 of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

- 17 Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under The Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by The Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
- 18 Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
- 19 No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the Board of The Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- 20 The Show will be held under Kennel Club Limited Rules and Show Regulations. All exhibitors shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Kennel Club Limited Rules and Show Regulations.

21 Best Veteran in Show

The Best Veteran in Show is a veteran which has competed and is unbeaten by any other veteran exhibited at the same show. A veteran is a dog which is aged no less than 7 years on the first day of the show, i.e. born on or before 9th March 2015.

A) Shows Judged on the Group System

- 1) Best Veteran in Breed
 - Best Veteran in Breed will be selected from all unbeaten veterans from ANY breed classes provided they are not beaten by any other veteran.
- 2) Best Veteran in Group
 - Best Veteran in Group and subsequent veteran group placings must be selected from:
 - (a) Those veterans declared Best Veteran in Breed.
 - (b) The Best Veteran from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day.
 - (c) The Best Veteran from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes in each group or on each day.
- 3) Best Veteran in Show
 - Best Veteran in Show must be selected from the Best Veteran in Group winners.
- 22 Entries must be posted on or before Tuesday 2nd August 2022 (postmark). HOWEVER, entries may be made online up to 12 noon on Tuesday 16th August 2022 at www.highampress.co.uk. WE WILL BE UNABLE TO ACCEPT FURTHER ENTRIES AFTER 12 NOON ON TUESDAY 16th AUGUST 2022.
- 23 Entries will not be acknowledged unless accompanied by a stamped addressed postcard. The only proof of posting acceptable to the Kennel Club is the certificate of posting, recorded delivery or registered post.
- 24 Exhibitors will receive a free, non-transferable pass for each dog entered, but in the case of a partnership entering only one dog, an additional pass will be provided.
- 25 Should any of the judges be prevented from fulfilling their engagement the Committee reserve to itself the right of appointing other judges to fulfil their duties. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition but no entry fees can be refunded.
- 26 The Committee is empowered to exclude or remove any dog that is not in a fit state for exhibition owing to disease, savage disposition or any other cause and all fees shall be forfeited.
- 27 Exhibitors are responsible for any damage done by their dogs whilst present at the show.
- 28 No part of the infrastructure of the show (including benches and tents) may be altered in any way except by authorized personnel.
- 29 The Committee will not be responsible for the loss or damage to a dog or dogs or any property whether arising from accident or any other cause nor for any act of omission of itself, its officers, servants or others and it is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.
- 30 The Committee can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold at the show.
- 31 All Rules and Regulations or definitions and instructions of the nature of rules and regulations, printed for convenience in other parts of this Schedule, shall be deemed to be regulations of the Committee and shall have the same effect as if they formed part of these Regulations. Should any question arise not provided for in these Regulations the decision of the Committee shall be final subject only to appeal to the Kennel Club.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

(Vide Kennel Club Regulations for Definitions of Classes)

PUPPIES UNDER SIX CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR EXHIBITION

N.B.—The word "dog" includes both sexes

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club e.g. CACIB/CAC/Green Star.

Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of postal entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. 26th July 2022.

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. First prizes awarded in any classes defined as Special do not count towards eligibility.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

Withdrawal

The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations F(1)19.

Transfer

- (a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under 12 calendar months of age, 18 calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class, to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

SPECIAL NOTE TO EXHIBITORS—Please pay particular attention to all age Classes. Age must be calculated as from the FIRST DAY of the Show.

MINOR PUPPY—For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

PUPPY - For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR-For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

YEARLING—For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty-four calendar months of age on the first day of the show. NOVICE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CAC/B/CAC/Green Star or three or more first prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

GRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

POST GRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

LIMIT—For dogs which have not become show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

OPEN—For all dogs of the breeds or varieties for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

VETERAN—For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

CHAMPION—For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion or Show Champion under Kennel Club Regulations or under any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS—For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a Challenge Certificate or Reserve Challenge Certificate, or for those breeds not allocated Championship Status, Best of Sex or Reserve Best of Sex at a Championship Show.

ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED—For breeds of dog for which no separate breed classes are scheduled. These classes are not open to breeds which are listed on the Imported Breed Register.

ANY VARIETY—A Variety Class is one in which more than one breed or variety of a breed with a breed standard can compete.

IMPORTED BREED REGISTER—For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by The Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class with the Best Imported Register / Best Imported Register Puppy being eligible for Best in Group / Best Puppy in Group or Best in Show / Best Puppy in Show as relevant. Such breeds may be entered into Imported Breed Register classes and/or Any Variety or Stakes classes, with the exception of AVNSC classes, for which they are not eligible.

KENNEL CLUB GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME—For dogs that have achieved their GCDS Bronze Award Certificate or above.


YKC STAKES - Only dogs of six (6) calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for entry into a YKC qualifying stakes class. Dogs must be on the Kennel Club Breed Register to compete in a YKC stakes competition. The first placed member only in each dog group at the qualifying show will qualify for Crufts. A rosette will be awarded. If a member is disqualified, the qualification does not roll down to the next placing. All pedigree dogs are eligible to take part provided the dog is registered on the Kennel Club Breed Register. The dog must be registered a) solely or jointly in the member's name or b) in the name of a close member of the family (i.e. a group of people related by blood or by marriage) and under these circumstances the dog must be resident at the YKC member's address. No substitute handlers are permitted — the dog must be handled by the registered YKC member. Members are not permitted to allow another individual to show their dog at the qualifier on their behalf if they are not able to attend the class, unless agreed by the YKC Office prior to the show. Members must be aged 6 - 24 years (members 6 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday). Please note that membership of the YKC terminates on a member's 25th birthday. Therefore if a member is aged 25 years or over by the first day of Crufts they will be unable to compete in any YKC class. Please keep this in mind when entering qualifiers throughout the competing year. In order to enter any YKC competition you must be a fully paid up member at the time of entry and competition. If you enter a Crufts qualifier and you have not previously paid your membership fee then any award will be forfeited Therefore it is important to renew and maintain YKC membership as current if you wish to participate in YKC competitions.

KC SPECIAL BEGINNERS COMPETITION - Special Beginners classes are scheduled for each breed plus the AV Not Separately Classified and AV Imported Breed Register classes in each group on each day of the show. The Best Special Beginner selected from the winners of these classes for each breed and the AV Not Separately Classified and AV Imported Breed Register classes will go forward to the competition for Best Special Beginner in Group on each day of the show. The Kennel Club will provide sponsorship in the form of Rosettes 1st - 4th for each group together with prize money of £100 for each group to be awarded as follows: 1st Prize £40; 2nd Prize £30; 3rd Prize £20; 4th Prize £10. There is no need for the winners of the Special Beginners Groups to return on the final day of the show. KENNEL CLUB BREEDERS' COMPETITION - Each team will consist of a minimum of three and maximum of four dogs of one breed, all bred by the same breeder or breeding partnership. The breeder enters the class and then arranges which dogs are exhibited on the day of the show. Please clearly state the name and affix of the registered breeder(s). Entries will not be taken on the day of the show. Teams will be awarded points/prize money in the KC Breeders' Competition as follows: Points 1st; 30; 2nd 15; 3rd 10; 4th 5. Prize Money 1st Non ABS Prize Fund £20; ABS Prize Fund £25. Please note that Assured Breeders will be credited with a higher prize value. These points will be recorded in the Kennel Club Breeders Competition record book through the year. The minimum qualification for the Crufts final will be 50 points, with a maximum of 40 finalists including the winning teams from the European and World Dog Shows' breeders competition. Our Dogs will collate the points and publish a leader board through the year.

Regulations For The Preparation of Dogs For Exhibition F (Annex B)

- These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club licensed event. Objections may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A11.
 - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
 - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A11.
- (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat
 for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external
 part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show.
 - (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- 3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:-
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the Board.
 - (b) The removal of dew claws of any breed.
 - (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.
 - Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the Board to deceive.
- 4. The Board without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the show secretary at his/her office before the close of the show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

EXHIBITORS

Gates will be open from 7.30 a.m. daily. Judging starts promptly at 9.00 a.m. unless otherwise advised in the information sent out with passes and/or published on the Society's web site or in the canine press. The proposed order of judging will be published, following the final closing of entries, in the canine press and on the Society's and Higham Press web sites. Judging may be brought forward to 8.30 a.m. in some rings. Printed copies of the show information leaflet will be provided with the passes sent out to exhibitors who make postal entries at least five working days prior to the first day of the show. Exhibitors who enter online will be notified by e-mail when their passes and the show information leaflet are available for download. All enquiries regarding the availability and delivery of passes should be made direct to Higham Press either by e-mail (mail@highampress.co.uk) or phone (01773 832 390). Benching will be provided for all entered dogs other than "Spectator Dogs". Cages will not be provided. There are no public telephones on site.

CATALOGUES

Catalogues will be provided on a pre-paid basis only and unless collected prior to 11.00am on the relevant day(s) may be offered for re-sale. Exhibitors wishing to pre-order catalogues may do so provided the appropriate fee, £6.00 per group catalogue and £8.00 per day catalogue, is received at the time of making postal or online entries. Members who are not exhibiting at the show but who may wish to order a catalogue for collection on arrival at the show may do so by using the entry form enclosed with their copy of the show schedule provided it is forwarded with the appropriate fee to the Secretary no later than 14 days prior to the show. A free information leaflet including details of the show layout and times of judging etc. will be available to members of the public on arrival at the show and information otherwise only available from the show catalogue can be obtained on enquiry at the help centre located in the show administration area.

VISITORS

Visitors to the show are admitted free of charge. Adults accompanied by children and/or minors are requested to ensure that reasonable standards of adult supervision and control are maintained whilst within the precincts of the show.

SPEED LIMIT

All officials, exhibitors, visitors, trade stand holders and contractors, are requested to drive with due care and attention at all times and to observe a maximum speed limit of 5 MPH whilst using the caravan and car parks and the avenue leading to and from the public highway into and out of the show ground.

CAR PARKING

Members: All paid up Members of the Society will be sent a Members' Car Park Pass, entitling them to park their vehicle in the provided areas prior to the show. Only one such pass can be provided per membership. Exhibitors: Exhibitors who pre-order an exhibitor car park pass at the time of making entries and display it on arrival at the venue will be directed to the designated parking area. Visitors: Members of the public arriving at the venue in their own vehicles may use the public car park at a cost of £10.00 per vehicle. Members and/or exhibitors arriving without pre-issued car park passes will be directed to the public car park.

FACILITIES FOR THE DISABLED

Car parking facilities for the disabled will be provided. Only vehicles displaying an official government issued disabled drivers' permit will be allowed to use this facility. Assistance for disabled persons to gain access to the show ground will be provided at the main entrance to the show. Toilets for the disabled will be available on the show ground.

CARAVANS, MOTORHOMES & TENTS A Caravan Park will be provided but without hook-up utilities. Caravans may be parked in this area at a cost of £55 (prepaid) or £65 if paid on arrival subject to availability. As space is limited we strongly advise pre-payment. Payment covers the period of the show or any part thereof. Access to the site is available from noon on the Wednesday prior to and until noon on the Monday following the show. The Society's appointed Warden will control the site. Carvan labels will be provided with entry passes and MUST be displayed at all times.

DOGS LEFT IN VEHICLES The Committee reserves the right to refuse the entries for future shows from exhibitors found to have left dogs in vehicles in a distressed condition. Remedial action will be taken if necessary. All such occurrences will be reported to the Kennel Club.

UNENTERED DOGS

A TENT FOR UNENTERED DOGS WILL NOT BE PROVIDED. Dogs aged four months and over may be entered NOT FOR COMPETITON (with provision of benching) at £13.50 per dog when making postal or online entries. Alternatively, unentered dogs maybe brought to the show and admitted as a SPECTATOR DOG at a cost of £10.00 per dog (benching not provided. provided the owner agrees to sign an undertaking to control their dog(s) whilst at the show.

PHOTOGRAPHY & VIDEO RIGHTS

The Organisers would like to bring the regulation on photography and filming to the attention of exhibitors, trade stand holders, press and visitors. It is a condition of all those attending the event that no filming or other form of recording may be taken or made without express written permission of the Organisers. The taking of photographs in the show venue for sale or reward is strictly prohibited except with the written permission of the Organisers. Press accredited photographers are provided with permission to take photographs ONLY for use in newspapers, magazines and internet-sites for news purposes only. There is no objection to the general public taking photographs of general views of the Show, provided that these are for private use. Specific dogs may be photographed only with the approval of the exhibitor. No photography or filming is permitted in breed judging rings whilst judging is actually taking place. However, judges may allow it to happen at the end of classes or after the Challenge Certificate is awarded. Filming and flash photography is allowed from outside the rings at all times unless the operation of the camera is actually

affecting exhibits. However, if a powerful flash unit is used or it is clear that exhibits are being affected, a ring steward or the judge is empowered to stop the person concerned.

Only dogs of six (6) calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for entry into a YKC qualifying stakes class. Dogs must be on the Kennel Club Breed Register to compete in a YKC stakes competition. The first placed member only in each dog group at the qualifying show will qualify for Crufts. A rosette will be awarded. If a member is disqualified, the qualification does not roll down to the next placing. All pedigree dogs are eligible to take part provided the dog is registered on the Kennel Club Breed Register. The dog must be registered a) solely or jointly in the member's name or b) in the name of a close member of the family (i.e. a group of people related by blood or by marriage) and under these circumstances the dog must be resident at the YKC member's address. No substitute handlers are permitted — the dog must be handled by the registered YKC member. Members are not permitted to allow another individual to show their dog at the qualifier on their behalf if they are not able to attend the class, unless agreed by the YKC Office prior to the show. Members must be aged 6 - 24 years (members 6 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday). Please note that membership of the YKC terminates on a member's 25th birthday. Therefore if a member is aged 25 years or over by the first day of Crufts they will be unable to compete in any YKC class. Please keep this in mind when entering qualifiers throughout the competing year. In order to enter any YKC competition you must be a fully paid up member at the time of entry and competition. If you enter a Crufts qualifier and you have not previously paid your membership fee then any award will be forfeited Therefore it is important to renew and maintain YKC membership as current if you wish to participate in YKC competitions. The erection of tents or gazebos within the precincts of the show is strictly prohibited.

PERSONAL INJURY & SAFETY

A Safety Officer will be in attendance throughout the show. Exhibitors and spectators are reminded that just as Richmond Dog Show Society has a responsibility to ensure the health and safety of all those attending their events, all those present have a duty and responsibility for their own safety.
