#### CARAVANS

£30 if paid with entries, £40 if paid on arrival (for the duration of the show or part thereof). Space on the caravan site is limited and early booking is advised with the Secretary. Caravans will be parked in a separate eight-acre field adjacent to the showground and linked by a tarmac footpath. Facilities include a toilet block (including disabled), shower block (in main building and accessible 24 hours), chemical disposal point and a fire point. A woodland site is available for exercising dogs on the strict understanding that dogs are kept on a lead at all times and any fouling is removed immediately, as this is a picnic area.

Caravans will be allowed on the site from 12 noon on Monday 16 January and must be removed by 12 noon on Monday 23 January 2023.

Please note that each caravan will be allocated a space of 10 metres in width. All equipment, including awning, windbreaks etc. must be contained within the allocated space and individual units must not be linked. Caravans/Motor homes over 8 metres in length are required to book and pay for two pitches.

The site will be under the control of the Society's appointed wardens and anyone not complying with his/her instructions will be asked to leave the site.
