Jurisdiction and responsibilities

The Officers and Committee members of the society holding the licence are deemed responsible for organising and conducting the show safely and in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Kennel Club and agree to abide by and adopt any decision of the Board or any authority to whom the Board may delegate its powers subject to the conditions of Regulation F17. In so doing those appointed as officers and committee members accept that they are jointly and severally responsible for the organisation of the show and that this is a binding undertaking (vide Kennel Club General Show Regulations F4 and F5).

The Society will ensure to the best of its ability that the event is run to Covid Safe guidelines. It is your responsibility to ensure you comply with national and local restrictions including advice given about non-essential travel in and out of locally affected regions (which must not be ignored) – in the interests of the safety of all participants this may give rise to a short notice refusal of entry at the society's discretion. The Kennel Club will respect the society's exercise of its discretion. If a competitor, or anyone in their household, has Covid-19 related symptoms or has tested positive for Covid-19 they must isolate in line with Government advice - www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/self-isolation-and-treatment/when-to-self-isolate-and-what-to-do/

NOT FOR COMPETITION ENTRIES will be accepted from any exhibitor with an additional dog or dogs whether or not that breed is scheduled at HOUNDSHOW, provided that dog is registered with the Kennel Club. Full particulars of each Not For Competition dog must be entered on the entry form so that he/she may be allotted a bench with the exhibitor's other exhibit(s).

The Not For Competition fee is a nominal £5.00. There is no excuse to leave your unentered dog in your vehicle. Remedial action will be taken immediately if any dog is found in a vehicle in a distressed condition and the exhibitor reported to the Kennel Club.

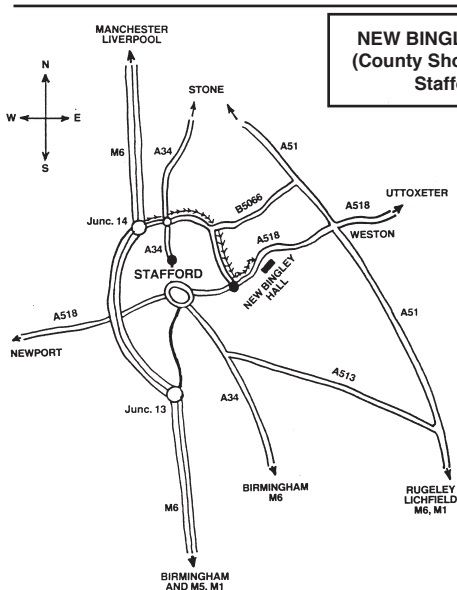

RULES AND REGULATIONS
for the **HOUND ASSOCIATION'S CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW**
to be held at the **COUNTY SHOWGROUND, WESTON RD., STAFFORD**
on **SATURDAY, 17th JULY 2021**
THIS SHOW IS OPEN TO ALL

- 1 The Show will open at 8.00 a.m.
- 2 Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
- 3 Judging will commence at 9.00 am.
- 4 Exhibits may be removed from the show after their judging has been completed. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club. The show will close half an hour after judging has been completed by which time dogs must be removed.
- 5 **Entry Fees:**
Members first entry per pound £22.00. Non-CC Breeds £12.00. Subsequent entries £5.00
Non-Members first entry per pound £25.00. Non-CC Breeds £14.00. Subsequent entries £5.00
Dogs entered Not for Competition £5.00. All Stakes classes: £15.00 if first entry. KC Breeders' Competition: £15.
Catalogue £7.00 pre-paid only. Caravan Pass: £25.00. Entries may be made online at www.highampress.co.uk.
- 6 **Prize money:**
Best in Show £50; Res. Best in Show £25; Best Puppy in Show £25; Res. Best Puppy in Show £15; Best Veteran in Show £25; Res. Best Veteran in Show £15. Stakes Classes: 1st £15, 2nd £10, 3rd £7, Res. £5, VHC £3. Royal Canin Group Puppy Stakes: 1st £20, 2nd £12, 3rd £8, Res. £6, VHC £3. Viscount Chelmsford: 1st £15; 2nd £10; 3rd £7; Res. £5; VHC £3. KC Good Citizen Class: 1st £50; 2nd £25; 3rd £15; 4th £10; 5th £5. Dorwest Herbs Bred by Exhibitor Stakes: 1st £7; 2nd £5; 3rd £4; Res. £3; VHC £2 (the overall winner from these four classes will receive a further £50). KC Breeder Competition: 1st £20, if Assured Breeder £25. Special Beginners Groups: G1 £40; G2 £30; G3 £20; G4 £10.
- 7 **Refusal of Entries:** The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 8 **Puppies:** Puppies under six calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
- 9 **Mating of Bitches:** The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
- 10 **Best Puppy in Show.**
Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed, Best of Group or Best in Show is a puppy it should automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Where the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best in Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group or Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.
(a) **Championship Shows Judged on the Group System**
(Definition; Shows judged on Group System - Refer to Regulation F.(1).27.b.)
 - 1) **Best Puppy in Breed**
A Best Puppy must be declared in each breed from puppies entered in the Breed Classes.
A Best AVNSC Puppy must be declared from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes.
A Best Puppy must be declared from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes
 - 2) **Best Puppy in Group**
Best Puppy in Group and subsequent Puppy Group placings must be selected from:-
 - a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed.
 - b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes on each day.
 - c) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Imported Breed Register classes on each day.
- 11 **Best in Show:**
The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Import Register.
Definition of a Category 3 Breed. A breed from time to time designated by the Board as requiring particular monitoring by reason of visible condition(s) which may cause health or welfare concerns. The list of designated Category 3 Breeds is kept under regular review.
 - 1) **Best of Breed**
Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.
NOTE: The Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified/Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register award relevant to a Category 3 will not be confirmed until the dog has passed an examination by the General and Group Championship Show Veterinary Surgeon. If the dog fails to pass the examination it is ineligible to compete in the relevant Group.
 - 2) **Best in Show**
Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.
- 12 **Admission to Groups:** Exhibits will not be admitted to Group or Best in Show competition after a period of

ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.

- 13 Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet to not touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
- 14 **Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition:** All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- 15 **Overseas Exhibitors:** All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- 16 **Dogs in Vehicles on Hot Days:** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

- 17 Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.
- 18 **Not For Competition:** Not For Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
- 19 No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- 20 **Best Veteran in Show. The Kennel Club Show Regulations stipulate that dogs must be entered and exhibited in a breed class before exhibiting in an Any Variety Class/Stakes Class and that only unbeaten dogs are eligible to compete in the group or best in show competitions are suspended. (Please refer to the FAQs on the Kennel Club Website for further information)**
- BEST VETERAN IN SHOW** is a Veteran which has competed and is unbeaten by any other Veteran (in breed classes) exhibited at the same show. Best Veteran In Breed will be selected from all unbeaten veterans from any breed classes provided they are not beaten by any other veteran. Best Veteran In Show (Group) will be selected from all Best Veteran in Breed provided they are unbeaten by any other veteran.
- Proviso.** For the purpose of this Regulation dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace, Team and Veteran or a Special Award, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.
- 21 **Abide By Rules:** The Show will be held under Kennel Club Limited Rules and Show Regulations. Every exhibitor making an entry or entries at this show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by Kennel Club Limited Rules and Regulations and by these Regulations, and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.
- 22 **Receipt of Entries:** Online entries can be made up to 12 noon on Wednesday 30th June 2021 at www.highampress.co.uk.
- 23 **Correct Fees:** No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fees, payable in Sterling. Cheques to be made payable to the HOUND ASSOCIATION in order for immediate payment.
- 24 **Exhibitor Passes:** No exhibitor passes will be sent out.
- 25 **Unentered Dogs:** No dog other than an exhibit duly entered at the Show will be allowed within the precincts of the Show during its continuance.
- 26 **Power to Exclude Dogs:** The Committee is empowered to exclude any dog which is not in a fit state for exhibition from disease, vice, natural or other causes, and if such exclusion takes place before or after the dog is judged, the entry fee will be forfeited.
- 27 **Benching:** No dog may be absent from its bench except for the purpose of being prepared for exhibition, judged, exercised or by order of the Veterinary Surgeon or Show Committee. No dog shall be absent from its bench for the purpose of exercise for longer than 30 minutes. All breeds will be benched in catalogue order and the owner's dogs of the same breed will be benched consecutively, without extra fee. No bench numbers shall be changed from one pen to another and no dog shall be benched on any but its own numbered bench. Under no circumstances may partitions between the dogs be removed.
- 28 **Responsibility:** The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of the dogs brought for exhibition but it must be clearly understood by exhibitors and purchasers of dogs and all other persons, that the Committee will not be responsible for the entire or partial loss or detention of or damage to a dog or dogs, boxes, hampers,

- collars or any other property whatever, arising from accident, or any other cause whatever, nor from any act or omission of themselves, their officers, agents, servants or others, and it is on this understanding only that entries are received. The committee will not be in any way responsible for any claim for injury or compensation occasioned by or arising out of the holding of the show or by reason of the act or default of any person or persons in attendance or present thereat. Parents/adults will be responsible for any damage caused by children in their care.
- 30 **Gangways & Grooming Areas:** The majority of breeds have a 10 foot gangway between benches and as long as exhibitors make sure there is a 6 foot clear space in the middle, they will be able to groom their dogs on or at their bench. Grooming areas are also provided by the Club for those wishing to use them or unable to groom at their bench. The use of chalk powders or any other similar substance is prohibited within the precincts of the show. See the KC Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition F(B).
 - 31 **Judging:** All Judges are requested to take the classes in each breed in the order in which they are entered in the Judging Book. Should any judged be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement, the Committee reserves to itself the right of appointing another in his/her place. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition but no entry fees can be refunded. Judges will be instructed and empowered to withhold the prize or prizes in any class if in their opinion the dog or dogs exhibited do not possess sufficient merit. Judges are not empowered to give prizes beyond those offered in this Schedule. The Judge's decision shall be final except in a case of fraud or misrepresentation or where a mistake has been made bona fide by the Judge.
 - 32 No animal other than a dog duly entered at the Show will be allowed in the precincts of the Show during its continuance.
 - 33 All Rules and Regulations, or definitions and instructions of the nature of Rules and Regulations printed for convenience in other parts of this Schedule, shall be deemed to be the Regulations of the Committee and shall have the same effect as if they formed part of these Regulations.
 - 34 The Committee will not be in any way responsible for any claim by exhibitors for any loss of valuables.
 - 35 In view of the pressure of work at the time of entries closing, entries cannot be acknowledged by return of post unless and addressed card accompanies the entry form.
 - 36 **Right of Appeal:** Should any question arise not provided for in these Regulations, the decision of the Committee shall be final, subject to appeal to the Kennel Club.
 - 37 **Enquiries etc.:** All correspondence, enquiries and letters should be addressed to the Hon. Secretary and the breed exhibited mentioned.
 - 38 **Fouling:** Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s) at any Kennel Club Licensed Show within the Licensed venue and within the environs of that event, including car and caravan parks and approaches. Adequate receptacles for the disposal of such fouling will be provided.
 - 39 **Control of Dogs:** The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club licensed events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches. This Regulation applies before (at any time during the set up period at the venue), during the event and afterwards (at any time during the breakdown of the event).

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.

Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of postal entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. Tuesday 22nd June 2021.

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

- (1) Withdrawal
The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulation F.(1).19.
- (2) Transfer
 - a. If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height or, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - b. For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - c. For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - d. If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY—For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

PUPPY—For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

JUNIOR—For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

YEARLING—For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

NOVICE: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

SPECIAL BEGINNERS—For owner, handler or exhibit not having won a Challenge Certificate or Reserve Challenge Certificate, or for those breeds not allocated Championship Status, Best of Sex or Reserve Best of Sex at a Championship Show.

UNDERGRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or three or more First Prizes at Championship Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

GRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

POST GRADUATE—For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

MID LIMIT—For dogs which have not become Show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won five or more First Prizes in all, at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

LIMIT—For dogs which have not become Show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won seven or more First Prizes in all, at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

OPEN—For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

IMPORTED BREED REGISTER—For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by The Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class only, with the winning dog Best Imported Register/Best Imported Register Puppy being eligible for Best in Group/Best Puppy in Group or Best in Show/Best Puppy in Show as relevant. Such breeds may be entered into Imported Breed Register classes and/or Any Variety or Stakes classes, with the exception of AVNSC classes, for which they are not eligible.

VETERAN—For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

BRACE—For two exhibits (either sex or mixed) of one breed belonging to the same exhibitor, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

PROGENY—For a dog or bitch, accompanied by at least three of its registered progeny. The dog or bitch not necessarily entered in another class however, all progeny having been entered and exhibited in another class. The dog or bitch and the progeny need not be registered in the same ownership.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR STAKES—The exhibit to have been bred, to be owned and handled by the breeder. In the case of a partnership the ownership and breeder details need to be exactly the same. The exhibit to be wholly handled by one of the partnership.

VARIETY CLASSES—An exhibit may now be entered and exhibited in Stakes classes **only** but will not then be eligible to Challenge for any other award in the breed or BIS/BPIS competition unless also entered in the breed.

SPECIAL OPEN WORKING—All hounds must either have hunted with a regulation pack, or successfully completed a scenting trial or be qualified as stated below. Entries must be accompanied by written authority from the Master of the pack, a Midland Basset Hound Club Scenting Trial Certificate awarded in the previous year, or hold a Working Certificate as specified.

SPECIAL OPEN WORKING TRIAL—(a) For Beagles and Bassets Griffons Vendéen which have hunted with a recognised pack or hold a Working Certificate recognised by the Kennel Club from a registered society. Entries from pack entered hunting hounds must be accompanied by written authority from the Master of the pack. (b) For Bloodhounds which have a permit to enter a Bloodhound Working Trial or Kennel Club licensed Working Trial held under Kennel Club regulations.

SPECIAL LURE CHASING DEERHOUND—For Deerhounds who have lure-chased at a recognised Club event. Name of Club to be given on entry form.

SPECIAL OPEN RACING OR LURE-CHASING—For Whippets who have won a race with a WCRA recognised club (passports must be produced on the day) or who have lure-chased with the BSFA, UKSS, or other K.C./F.C.I. recognised clubs and for Greyhounds who must be registered with the KC and also registered with the NGRC or the NCC.

GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME CLASS—For dogs that have achieved their GCDS Bronze Award Certificate or above.

KENNEL CLUB SPECIAL BEGINNERS COMPETITION—A new competition sponsored by the Kennel Club. A Special Beginners class for dogs and bitches where AVNSC and Imported Breed Register classes are scheduled. The Best Special Beginner to be declared for each breed plus AVNSC and Imported Breed Register classes go forward to the group competition. For class definition see above. The Kennel Club will provide sponsorship in the form of Rosettes 1st - 4th for each group together with prize money or £100 for each group to be awarded as follows: 1st Prize £40; 2nd Prize £30; 3rd Prize £20; 4th Prize £10. There is no need to return on the final day.

NOT FOR COMPETITION—Societies may at their discretion, accept Not For Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed.


KENNEL CLUB BREEDERS' COMPETITION—Each team will consist of a minimum of three and maximum of four dogs of one breed, all bred by the same breeder or breeding partnership. The breeder enters the class and then arranges which dogs are exhibited on the day of the show. Please clearly state the name and affix of the registered breeder(s). Entries will not be taken on the day of the show. Teams will be awarded points/prize money in the KC Breeders' Competition as follows: Points 1st 30; 2nd 15; 3rd 10; 4th 5. Prize Money 1st Non ABS Prize Fund £20; ABS Prize Fund £25. Please note that Assured Breeders will be credited with a higher prize value. These points will be recorded in the Kennel Club Breeders' Competition record book through the year. The minimum qualification for the Crufts final will be 50 points, with a maximum of 40 finalists including the winning teams from the European and World Dog Shows' Breeders' Competition. Our Dogs will collate the points and publish a leaderboard through the year.

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F (B)

- 1 These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.
 - (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
 - (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A42.
- 2
 - (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the Show.
 - (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- 3 No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
 - (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed.
 - (c) Operations to prevent breeding, provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.

Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
- 4 The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 5 An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 6 Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.
