



**From Bakewell:** Take the A6 - Matlock - Haddon Road. This road is for Haddon Hall/Peak Shopping Village. On leaving the town, the venue is on the left. Turn left off Haddon Road, down Agricultural Way, then the venue is just over the bridge. The 'Dog Field' is on the right with car parking opposite which is signposted.

**From Matlock:** Take the A6 Buxton/Bakewell road. Follow this road through Rowsley village, passing the Peak Shopping village, the Grouse and Claret and Peakcock Hotel on the right. Follow dual carriageway, past Haddon Hall. The venue is on the right as you enter Bakewell. Turn right into Agricultural Way.

**From the M1:** Take exit 29 for Chesterfield, then follow signs to Bakewell/Baslow A619.

**From A38:** Exit Alfreton and keep left for A615 Matlock and pick up the A6 - Buxton/Bakewell. Alternatively, you can take the A6 from Derby and keep on this road to Matlock and Bakewell.

**Areas of local interest to the site are:** Chatsworth House and Gardens, Haddon Hall (Elizabethan Hall), Peak Shopping Village, Matlock Bath.

**Accommodation:** This is a very popular tourist area. Early booking is essential. Within 30 minutes drive are; Premier Inn, Eastmoor, Chesterfield. Travelodge (Alfreton Junction A38) and Ibis Hotel, Chesterfield.

## Regulations For The Preparation of Dogs For Exhibition F (Annex B)

1. These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A 42.
  - a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
  - b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A 42.
2.
  - a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the Show.
  - b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
  - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
  - (b) The removal of dew claws of any breed.
  - (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.Nor must anything be done calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate) to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

### Dog Fouling and Grooming Waste

- a) Any Owner, Exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove immediately any fouling caused by their dog(s) and/or any grooming waste at any Kennel Club Licensed Show within the Licensed Venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches.
- b) Any Organisation holding a Kennel Club Licensed event is required to provide an adequate number of receptacles for the disposal of such fouling and waste.

**WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**

- 17. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show
- 18. **Not For Competition:** Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
- 19. **Regulations:** No modifications will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- 20. **Dog Fouling:** Any owner, competitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s) at any Kennel Club licensed show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches. Adequate receptacles for the disposal of such fouling will be provided.
- 21. **Responsibility.** The Committee will not in any way be responsible for any claims for injury or compensation or loss of property occasioned by or arising out of the holding of the Show or by reason or act or default of any person in attendance or present thereat.
- 22. **Exclusion of Dogs.** The Committee is empowered to exclude any dog which is not in a fit state for competition from disease, vice, natural or other causes and if such exclusion takes place before or after the dog is judged, the entry fee will be forfeited. (Vide KC Show Reg 15).
- 23. **Replacement of Judges.** If any judge is unable to fulfill an engagement, the Committee reserves the right to appoint a replacement. In these circumstances, exhibitors may withdraw from competition, but no entry fees will be returned.
- 24. **Alterations.** An announcement prior to date of closing of entries in Our Dogs or Dog World of any alteration or addition to the Schedule or these Regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
- 25. **Regulations F. F9 Exhibition of Dogs:**
  - a) No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time whilst at the licensed venue including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches.
  - b) The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches.

## COVID REGULATIONS

This show will be held in line with Kennel Club and Government guidelines in place at the time of the show. If an exhibitor, or anyone in their household, has COVID related symptoms or has tested positive for COVID19 within the past month, they must not attend the show. Entry details will be shared, if requested, by Track and Trace. Bring your own chairs. Please ensure the cages are a minimum of two metres from other exhibitors. Social distancing to be maintained at all times. Face coverings are to be worn by exhibitors, the judge and steward whilst in the ring (unless medically exempt). The handler will show the dog's teeth to the judge. The grooming table will be sanitised after assessing each dog.

## DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of postal entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. **Friday 9th July 2021**. Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

- (1) Withdrawal.  
The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulation 20.
- (2) Transfer.
  - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
  - b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy Class, Puppy Class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class to the Open Class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
  - c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer It to the Open Class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.
  - d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

<b>MINOR PUPPY</b>	For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
<b>PUPPY</b>	For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
<b>JUNIOR</b>	For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
<b>NOVICE:</b>	For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).
<b>GRADUATE:</b>	For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.
<b>POST GRADUATE</b>	For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.
<b>LIMIT</b>	For dogs which have not become show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.
<b>OPEN</b>	For all dogs of the breed for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.
<b>VETERAN</b>	For dogs of seven years and over on the first day of the Show.
<b>BRACE</b>	For two exhibits (either sex or mixed) of one breed, belonging to the same exhibitor, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace.
<b>NOT FOR COMPETITION</b>	Societies may, at their discretion, accept Not For Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted from any breed.
<b>JUNIOR HANDLING ASSOCIATION CLASSES</b>	Entries will not be taken at the show. Dogs must be entered in breed class. The name and age of the Junior Handler must be given in the box provided on the entry form together with the class number. Those handlers placed first, second and third will be eligible to compete in the semi-finals at six national Group Championship shows.

## RULES and REGULATIONS

1. **Opening of Show:** The Show will open at 8.30 am.
2. **Arrival of Dogs:** Dogs will be received until 11.00 am and after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management.
3. **Judging Time:** Judging will commence at 11.00 am and exhibitors will be responsible for their dogs being on time for judging.
4. **Removal of Dogs.** Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show Management, then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed by which time dogs must be removed.
5. **Fees:** Members £15.00 First entry each dog. Members Subsequent Entries FREE. Non-Members £25.00 First entry each dog. Non-Members Subsequent Entries £5.00. Junior Handler £3.00 per class (dog must be entered in another class at this show). Not For Competition: £1.00 per dog. Catalogues: £4.00 pre-paid with entries, £5.00 on the day. **Entries can be made online at [www.highampress.co.uk](http://www.highampress.co.uk).**
6. **Prize Money:** Best in Show £20.00, Reserve Best in Show £10.00, Best Puppy £10.00, Reserve Best Puppy £5.00, Best Veteran £5.00.
7. **Refusal of Entries:** The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
8. **Puppies:** Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
9. **Mating of Bitches:** The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
10. **Best Puppy in Show:** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed or Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed or Best in Show is a puppy it should automatically be awarded Best Puppy in Breed and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Where the Reserve Best of Breed or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it should also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.
11. **Best in Show:** The dog declared Best in Show must be selected from those dogs which have been declared Best of Breed or Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Best of Breed(s) and the dog/bitch declared by the breed judge to be Reserve Best of Breed to the dog declared Best in Show.
12. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
13. Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
14. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) - Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
15. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
16. **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
  - When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
  - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
  - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
  - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
  - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
  - Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
  - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended

Right to Refuse Entries: Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.

### CHEQUES

The Society name must be written in full or your cheque will be returned.

The banks are now scanning cheques as you pay them in. Cheques that are not written using black ink, or don't have the society name written in full, will be rejected. Failure to follow the above criteria means your entry will be returned.


